# Preamble and problematic of the National Colloquium

After more than seven decades since the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, it has become necessary to assess the reality of human rights in light of the actual practices of States, and to the content

of said declaration..

The Conversal Declaration of Human Rights includes a wide range of fundamental rights and freedoms, notably the equality in dignity and freedom from discrimination. Indeed, the international community is witnessing a dark reality in terms of human rights and a decline in freedoms, which threatens to further undermine the principles of non-discrimination, equal dignity with a view to building fairer and more stable societies.

Based on the fact that the principles of equality and non-discrimination are anchored at the heart of human rights and are consistent with the 2030 Agenda and the approach of the United Nations stipulated in the common framework concerning the inclusion of all without any exception, this national forum aims to assess the current state of human rights By adopting diverses approaches and visions, such as the legal approach, the political approach, and the religious approach.

### The importance of the National Forum:

The importance of this National Forum lies in the 'importance of the question of the protection of human rights in itself, given the violations recorded throughout the world and which affect human dignity in general. This is why the subject of human rights is one of the most controversial topics of discussion.

# Objectives of the National Forum:

This national forum aims to achieve several objectives, such as:

assessing the effectiveness of international human rights conventions, as well as human rights monitoring bodies.

- see if the multiplication of international mechanisms for the protection of human rights, both political and judicial, has really contributed to the improvement of human status and respect for international rights

- 2. Universal Declaration of Human Rights
- 3. International political and judicial bodies concerned with the protection of human rights

Axis 3: approaches to interpreting human rights

- 1. Legal approach: A reading of the most important international legal texts relating to human rights.
- 2. The political approach: the political dimension of the philosophy of human rights.
- 3- Religious approach: Religious considerations of human rights in the face of legal obligations and political considerations

Axis 4: Human rights in the world: reality and perspectives

- Different models of human rights between the North and the South
- Anticipate the future of human rights and measures to address imbalances and gaps in international human rights law
