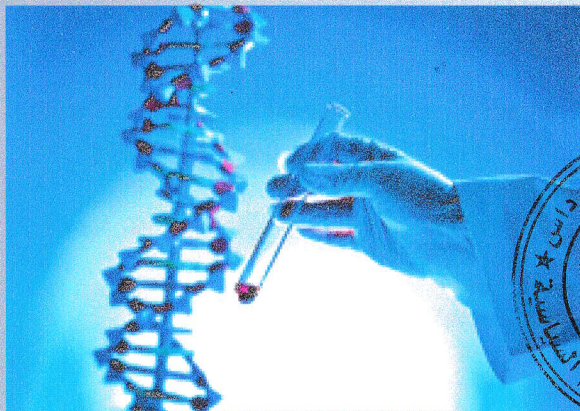

Work efficiency, quality of life, and sustainable development. It is considered a key to developing the digital economy and biotechnology and achieving innovation in many fields



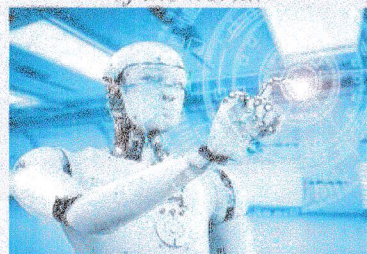
The problem of the forum
