Preamble:

Introducing the strategy of teaching in English in all disciplines -including law- put by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research is an important approach as it enhances and strengthens the target global high quality scientific production. However, the world classification of scientific research is linked to foreign languages command, as most classified scientific journals require the official global languages publications, including English.

In this context, the role of higher education institutions comes to keep pace with the strategy of the Ministry of Higher Education and scientific research to embody this goal in reality. However, the introduction of teaching law in English at the post graduation level for about seven years emphasizes the necessity of making this endeavour successful.

1 The objectives of the National Conference

This National Conference tends to improve the quality of teaching law in English through suggested programs to achieve a high-level quality. However, it targets:

1-The presentation of an overview of the current programs adopted for the Horizontal Teaching Unit as a starting point for teaching law in English in our universities.

2-The evaluation of these current programs and the number of semesters assigned to them.

- The list of references is written at the end of the paper.

- The number of pages varies between 12 to 20 pages.
