#### Preamble

The spread of the Corona virus - COVID-19 - and its transformation into a global pandemic has led to the emergence of new challenges faced by the world due to the escalation of the severity of the health crisis, the evolution of the number of infections and deaths, and the impact on various economic, political, social and health fields. Most countries of the world have resorted to applying strict measures from vaccinating citizens, closing borders and preventing travel to applying quarantine and social distancing, all measures and procedures that helped to limit the rise in the number of infected people in the world.

Algeria, like other countries around the world, has suffered from the spread of this virus, so it has taken several measures and precautionary measures to preserve public health and maintain its health security, which has made it necessary to reconsider the health policies adopted in the future and develop strategies to face epidemics in order to ensure health and national security, which has become vulnerable to the non-traditional threats it faces.

#### Problematic

Through the activities of this national forum, we will try to address the following question:

How can Algeria adopt an effective strategy to achieve health security in light of the threats in the field of public health, especially after the corona virus pandemic?

### **Objectifs**

- 1- Highlighting the concept of health security and its overlap with some other concepts.
- 2- To identify the reasons for the spread of the Corona virus in Algeria, as it poses a threat to public health and the health system, with a reading of the reality of health security in Algeria during and after the Corona virus pandemic.
- 3- Trying to study the most important experiences of countries that were able to contain the virus and re-adapt their health security to the developments of the epidemiological situation of the virus in order to achieve health security.

#### main axes

- -Chapter 1: The conceptual framework of health security and its relationship with human security and national security
- -Chapter 2: The reality of health security in Algeria and the threats it faces after the coronavirus pandemic (health system, epidemics, climate change, nutrition ....).
- -Chapter 3: The experiences of some countries in the field of health security.
- -Chapter 4: Frameworks and mechanisms to address threats and risks to the health security of Algerian citizens (health system reform, digitisation, international cooperation, prevention, vigilance and surveillance system, funding plans...).
- -Chapter 5: The future of health security in Algeria after the corona virus pandemic challenges and bets.

## condition of participation

The entry must not have been previously published or shared.

- -Not less than 12 pages and not more than 15 pages.
  -Font type for the Arabic language is SakkalMajalla, size 16, margins (2 cm on each side), the distance between lines is 1.15 cm. Foreign language interventions should be in Times New Roman font size 14, margins 2 cm on each side, and the distance between lines 1 cm.
- -The abstract and the full intervention should be sent in Arabic, English or French, respecting the relevant scientific controls.
- -Individual and bilateral interventions are accepted, with priority given to individual interventions.
