Preamble and problematic of the National Colloquium

Digital technologies are an important means of supporting, defending, and exercising human rights and influencing all types of rights, including civil and political rights, in addition to cultural, economic, and social rights. However, there are those who believe that these digital technologies are also used to violate and suppress these rights, through online surveillance, censorship, and harassment, or through the misuse of these technologies that may disproportionately affect marginalized individuals and groups, leading to inequality and discrimination, whether online or in real life.

The value of digital technology for human rights is very great, as it allows for communication and connection with people around the world, mobilization, information, and investigation, and the use of encrypted communications, satellite images, and data flows to directly defend and promote human rights. Focusing on human rights in the digital age is essential, and although the digital revolution is a fundamental global human rights issue, its clear benefits cannot in any way cancel out its risks, especially in light of artificial intelligence.

Among the things that affect human rights in the digital age, we mention some manifestations, for example, but not limited to, incitement to hatred and violence, the spread of harassment, phishing campaigns, intimidation, fear and bullying.

On the other hand, the protection of individuals' personal data is one of the rights stipulated in international standards, in the European Union treaties and in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union.

The importance of the subject lies in the multiplicity of personal data, as there is inventory data (e.g. names and addresses), content data (e.g. entries in online forms), contact data (e.g. email and phone numbers), identification / contact data (e.g. information about devices and Internet Protocol (IP) addresses).

The progress of societies has become essentially apparent in their arrival to a digital age, and the positive characteristics of this digital age do not eliminate some problems with regard to human rights, which makes us ask the following fundamental question: How can human rights be protected in the digital age?

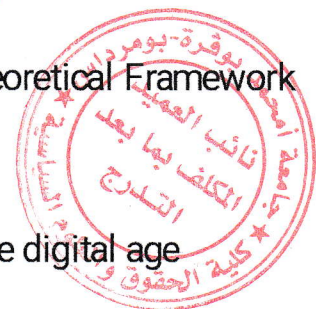

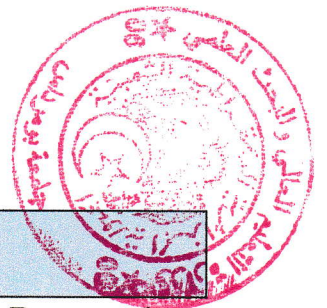

- ✓ Accepted interventions will be published in the conference book or in a special issue of the laboratory journal.

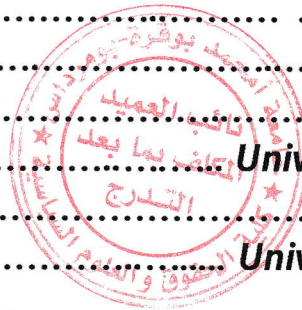
