### Preamble

Since independence, the Algerian state has focused on the economic sector, shaping and driving it to play a significant role in achieving development, which had repercussions on the social and political aspects. It adopted a socialist economic approach based on state ownership of the means of production and the adoption of a public monopoly policy for various economic activities, relying on the public economic institution, which took several forms during this phase to implement the development plan and meet the essential needs of the citizens.

In order to succeed the public economic sector and ensure its sustainability, many reforms were initiated, especially providing financial support. However, the economic and financial crisis of the late 1980s prompted the Algerian state to adopt comprehensive economic reforms, including re-evaluating the management of the public economic sector and adopting a liberal approach as an alternative to the socialist one, based on the principle of free trade, investment, and entrepreneurship. This was achieved by opening up initiatives for the private sector to engage in economic activities after liberating them from public monopoly, making it a key player in building the national economy and achieving sustainable development. The intended goal of these reforms was to drive the public economic sector to achieve economic efficiency and meet the desired objectives However, to this day, it still faces significant financial problems and has not been able to achieve the set results. With the revolution in information and communication technologies and the trend of countries towards a knowledge-based or post-knowledge economy through investment in innovation and creativity, we wonder about the feasibility of continuing to rely on the public economic sector in light of the developments in information and communication technology.

Accordingly, the seminar's issue revolves around: the effectiveness of the public economic sector in achieving economic goals under the adoption of the liberal system and how it can contribute to achieving sustainable development in the context of the information and communication technology revolution.

## Objectives of the forum

- 1.Understanding the concept of the public economic sector and distinguishing it from the private sector.
- 2. Familiarity with the various institutions that make up and constitute the economic public sector, as there is no clear legal text defining the individuals of the economic public sector.
- 3.Addressing the emergence of the public economic sector, the various reforms it has undergone, its current status, and the bodies responsible for its management.
- 4. Highlighting the oversight of the economic public sector, especially the financial oversight by the Court of Auditors for financial support, as well as the volume of public investments, which have only achieved low rates of return.
- 5. Diagnosing the main obstacles and problems that prevent the public economic sector from playing a role in sustainable development.
- 6.Study of the opportunities for the survival of the public economic sector in light of the developments of the information and communication technology revolution and the shift towards a knowledge economy.
